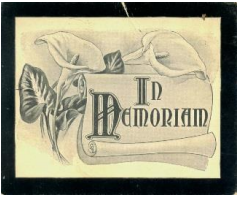

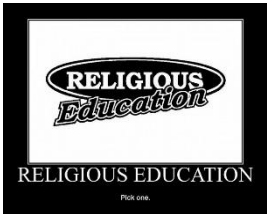

Religious Education classes began at St. Ann's on September 18, 2016, and are held each Sunday immediately following the 10:00am Mass. **So far, attendance at the Religious Education Classes has been very poor with many of our children having attended only one or no classes at all.** Please remember that Religious Education is not just Sacramental Preparation (ie: First Holy Communion or Confirmation); although this is a big part of the education. Just as importantly, though, is that Religious Education equips students with social, spiritual, and moral knowledge that helps them within our society. The lessons learned in religious education prepare them for responsibilities and experiences later in life that are reflected in their behaviors and communication. When faced with a dilemma, they can reflect on the teachings of the church to make a decision that is in line with their values and beliefs. Please make sure that your child attends their Religious Education classes. **For those children in Sacramental Preparation (ie: First Holy Communion & Confirmation), if more than 5 classes are missed during this school year, the child will not receive their First Communion or Confirmation. Attendance is necessary for learning!!**

Remember, the children are asked to please bring their friends if they wish. Food, popcorn, candy and drinks will be provided.
