The beginning of the Lenten Season is this coming Wednesday, March 1, 2017 with our ASH Wednesday services. Mass times for distribution of ashes will be at 12:00 Noon and 7:00pm on the 1<sup>st</sup>.

Every Friday during Lent, we will be offering a Lenten Dinner in the Parish Hall. The Dinners will begin at 6:00pm and the Stations of the Cross will be given immediately after the meals at approximately 6:45pm. **The first Lenten Dinner is Friday, March 3, 2017**, and the menu is: A variety of fish, roasted potatoes, corn, cole slaw and a drink. Any donation you wish to make will be accepted for the meals, and all are invited to attend.

## Church Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. \*Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday. \* On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. \* Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
