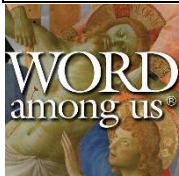

The beginning of the Lenten Season is ten short days from now on Wednesday, February 14, 2018 beginning with our ASH WEDNESDAY services. Mass times for distribution of ashes will be at 12:00 Noon and 7:00pm on the 14th.

Church Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. "Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday. "On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not apply. *Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.



The Word Among Us, A complete Catholic Mass and Daily Meditation Booklet will be available on Ash Wednesday for you to pick up for your Lenten mediation and prayers. The booklets will be on the table at the front of the church, and will also be available in the Chapel.
