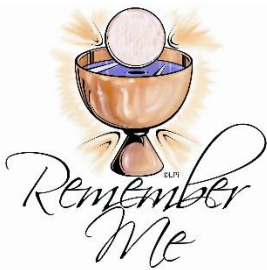
St. Ann Altar Society will host a dinner meeting on Thursday, June 14, 2018 at 6:00pm at Oliverios.
