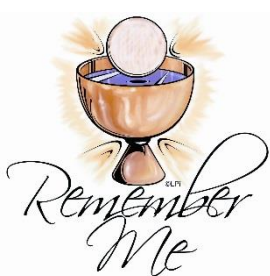
**JOB OPPORTUNITY**
