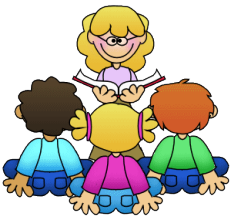

Miracle of Bolsena: A mass in Blesna, depicted in a famous fresco by Raphael at the Vatican in Rome, was an incident said to have taken place in 1263. A Bohemian priest who doubted the doctrine of transubstantiation, celebrated the mass at Bolsena, a town north of Rome. During the mass the bread of the eucharist began to bleed. The blood from the host fell onto the altar linen in the shape of the Face of Jesus as traditionally represented, and the priest came to believe. The following year, in 1264, Pope Urban IV instituted the Feast of Corpus Christi to celebrate this miraculous event. The gold-plated silver and enamel reliquary was made in 1337-1338 by Sinese Goldsmith Ugolino di Viere to the house of relic. The blood stained Corporal of Bolsena is still venerated as a major relic in Orvieto Cathedral in central Italy.
