Exploring Liturgical Signs and Symbols within our Catholic Church: Oil is an ancient symbol still used by the Church. Liturgical anointing with oil is symbolic of a special relationship between a person or object and God. In the Old Testament, memorial tablets were anointed (Genesis 31:13) as well as the priest (Exodus 8:12) and the king (I Samuel 10:1). In the New Testament, oil was associated with healing. The oil used for medical and hygienic purposes became a symbol of healing of both body and spirit (James 5:14). Today, oil is used as a sign of healing in the Anointing of the Sick. In Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders, it symbolises our being set aside and sealed to do the work of the Lord. Oil is a symbol rich in the Catholic tradition and one which can be effectively used in many kinds of liturgical celebrations.
