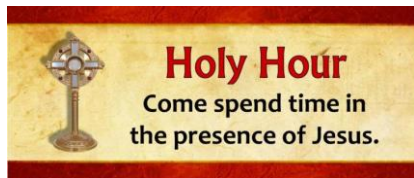

Sunday, December 2 is the First Sunday of Advent and is also the beginning of a new liturgical season. The Advent Season includes four Sundays. The Christmas Season follows and includes the celebration of the birth of Christ, as well as the Feast of the Holy Family, the Feast of the Mother of God and Epiphany.



Saturday, December 8, 2018 is a Holy Day of Obligation (The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary). A Vigil Mass will be offered at 7:00pm on Friday, December 7, 2018, and Mass will be offered again at 8:30am on Saturday, December 8th.

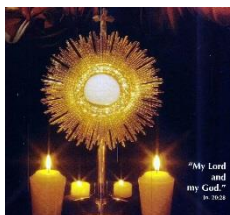
